The Mexican Christian Mission (MCM) continues to be used by the Lord in so many exciting ways. This past month we

discovered that Arias, the daughter of Pastor Rodrigo Vallarta was approaching her 15th birthday. However, the problem was that the pastor and his family did not have the resources to be able to organize a party for her. In the Hispanic culture, the 15th birthday for girls is a major event known as the Quinceniera. Thankfully the Lord used MCM to provide a birthday celebration for her. One of the volunteers from the Rock Church offered to donate a lovely peach dress for Arias. In addition, recent donations we received allowed us to organize a party for Arias at Pastor Rodrigo's church with the entire congregation staying to enjoy a time of pizza, cake and fellowship.

On Saturday, prior to Arias birthday, MCM organized a children's outreach with Pastor Rodrigo's church, Lo Mejor del Trigo (The Best of the Wheat).





The children's outreach also proved to be very fruitful as 25 kids were saved! The lord keeps opening the doors for events like this.

This past month the MCM "Family Support Program" blessed several families by providing them with diapers! One was a mother of 3 diaper aged children who was abandoned by her husband earlier this year. Another was the family of a pastor who is suffering from an advanced case of cancer. Also, Norma Flores was assisted by MCM this past month by providing her family with a complete grocery run to help them during a most difficult time. Norma suffers from a case of advanced diabetes and can barely walk; her oldest daughter, Sara, has knee problems and cannot move very well.

Norma's father is a taxi driver and earns very little money and due to his age and health issues he is ineligible for other positions of work.

Going forward, MCM is exploring the possibility of having a large conference in Tijuana on Homosexuality. The goal is to equip pastors and leaders with this information so they can help people overcome these spiritual struggles. Pastors from 19 churches have indicated that they want to sponsor this event. The event would be for one day and would cover 3 areas: 1.) What Scriptures say and how pro-gay theologians are attempting to change God's word. 2.) The medical aspects and risks associated with homosexuality. 3.) What to do when someone in your church approaches you and says he/she is struggling with same-sex attractions.

For the remainder of this year we will continue to support families, especially those without a father, with food and other related needs. We are, also planning one more children's outreach in November or early December 2013.
