Every month is unique with the Mexican Christian Mission (MCM). We never know what the Lord will do, what special family or pastor we might be introduced to or what new type of event we will host. During the past few months, we met several families with very special needs and as always, the Lord provided the resources we needed to deliver some wonderful blessings to these families.



Last month, the blessings continued when we were introduced to the family of Pastor Luciano and Anita Gonzalez. They have two daughters ages 4 and 18 months. Luciano is pastor of a small church near central Tijuana. Less than one year ago, Luciano started noticing inflammation in his left ankle; within a few weeks his ankle had inflamed several inches.

Luciano went to the hospital and was diagnosed with an aggressive form of bone cancer. Within weeks he could no longer walk. With Luciano unable to work and no other family members available in Tijuana to help, their situation became critical. Pastor Luciano has been receiving chemotherapy treatments which have greatly weakened

him and the doctors are considering amputating the lower part of his left leg, however the cancer has spread to other areas. MCM was informed of this situation and we delivered a large Costco blessing to them. The mother, Anita, wept when she saw the blessing! MCM will continue to monitor this situation and do whatever we can to help them through this difficult period. Please keep this family in your prayers!!

During August, MCM helped buy diapers for two other families. Diapers are expensive and can drain what little budget families have therefore reducing the amount of funds they can spend on food. Glory be to God, that we can continue to be a channel through which He is pouring much needed assistance to these struggling families.



Our next children's outreach will be on Saturday September 21. This event will take place on the east edge of Tijuana (pictured left). It is so exciting when the Lord opens new areas for us to go to and proclaim the message of salvation in an open-air setting!

With your support we will continue to share the gospel and help families that are struggling to meet their basic needs.
