MEXICAN CHRISTIAN MISSION July 2014

At the Mexican Christian Mission (MCM) we are continually presented with opportunities to demonstrate the love of God to other people. In our previous newsletter, we introduced Antonieta, and her mother (pictured left), her 2 year



old boy and a 9 month old girl. The father went to live with another women. Antonieta remained home to take care of her mother and her two lovely children; she had not been able to provide for her family members because she couldn't get work. Antonieta, who committed her life to Christ earlier this year, never complained about her situation. Pastor Velazquez and his wife shared with us what was happening. We visited her about two weeks ago and delivered the large food blessing and also gave her hundreds of diapers for her babies. Pastor Velazquez reported that she is doing very well and the little resources Antonieta's father is able to bring in is making a difference now.

(3)), were abandoned by Angela's husband over a year ago; she also has a sick mother to take care of and her father

works as a taxi driver earning maybe \$35 US dollar equivalent a week. They were blessed by a relative who gave them a place to live in, but still so many struggles. MCM provided this family with a huge food run; and a number of items that are suitable for her mother, Isabel, who has diabetes.

Estela with her 2 children was another family we assisted. She also has diabetes and is slowly losing her vision. She has very little strength in her arms, no husband to support her and relies on her 10 year old girl to do most of the manual labor around the house. We prayed for Estella (pictured right) on our first visit last month and returned a week later providing a large grocery delivery to take care of her essential needs.



A few weeks ago, we had the privilege of providing hot dogs and drinks to over 100 men at a drug and alcohol rehab



center in Tijuana. We also translated Tim Neisler's message. Tim is an outreach leader from the Rock Church. About 50 men responded to Tim's call and asked Christ into their lives!

MCM received another blessing when a pastor invited us to present the pornography conference at his church. On Sunday July 27 we will be presenting a message distinguishing Christianity from Islam. Sunday August 17 we will present the topic of envy and jealousy. Our next children event will be at the end of August in a factory with 100 to 200 children. More to come on that soon!
